Professionals that are already members of the *American College of Neuropsychopharmacology* may now apply for CINP membership without an additional vetting process and their membership levels will be matched accordingly. Therefore, CINP has decided to automatically approve membership applications for the following members of your society.

- ACNP Fellow → CINP Fellow
- ACNP Member → CINP Fellow
- ACNP Associate Member → CINP Member

All of CINP's membership categories have thus been opened to this procedure.

Members of the neuropsychopharmacological community often already are de facto members of one or more associations worldwide. CINP therefore wishes to modernize and improve on its membership application procedures, recognizing each incoming member's pre-existing status with another society equally.

New members that are not already part of another association will have to undergo the vetting process as set out in CINP's membership application forms.
